### \*\* REMINDERS \*\*



**\*Permits Required.** ATV's and golf carts are legal on the streets in Boyden within City limits, but you must have a permit. Permit applications and a copy of the governing ordinance can be obtained from the City Office.

**\*Splashpad!** Weather permitting; The Boyden Splashpad is set to open the last week of May.

**\*Centennial Park Hours:** the park is closed 11 p.m.-5 a.m.

**\*Shelter House Reservations** can be made through the City Office at 725-2371.



**\*City Dump.** Plastic garbage bags and cardboard are not allowed in the city dump. Please empty your compost and personally dispose of containers.

**\*Don't forget to obtain a building permit** for any structure you plan to build, alter, or change prior to the commencement of the project. Pick up at City Office.

**\*Be a responsible pet owner:** Keep your animals leashed and on your own property. When walking your pets, respect others' property by picking up the "deposits" they may leave along the way.



**\*For dogs found running at large** please call Sioux County Law Enforcement (737-2280) to report dogs running at large within the community or on your property.

**\*Utility Bill Payments-** please remember to enclose the small portion of the postcard with your payment. Thanks!

These ordinances govern the following thing and are not limited to landscaping, weeds or grass that needs to be mowed or trimmed, junk items, abandoned vehicles or small machinery items (lawn mowers, etc.), and general overall property clean up. 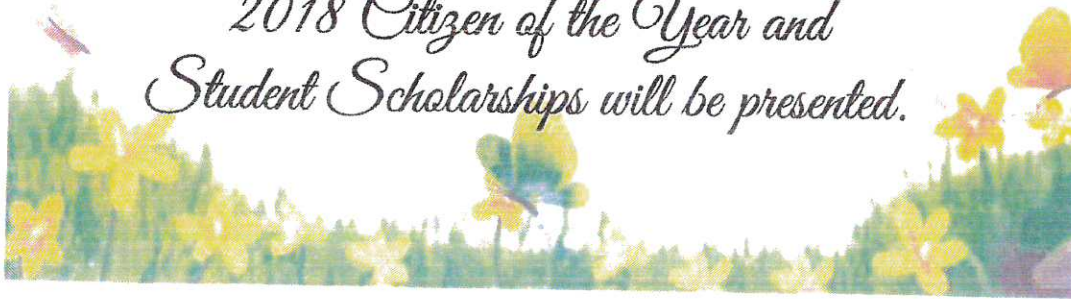

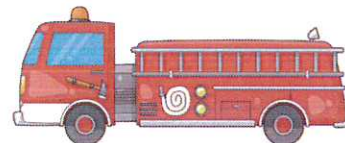
